Neubauer named to First Federal of Greene County's Board

WAYNESBURG, PA – The Board of Directors of First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Greene County recently appointed Stephen M. Neubauer, president and CEO of Neubauer's Flowers & Market House in Uniontown, to a vacant seat on the board.

"I am quite honored to be joining the board," Neubauer said. "Having grown up in Waynesburg, I am very well aware of the reputation and great service provided by First Federal of Greene County. I hope that with my 34 years of Fayette County perspective, along with my Greene County roots, I can continue the legacy of service to the communities that the Association serves."

Born and raised in Waynesburg, Neubauer is the son of the late Richard H. Neubauer and Doris Neubauer, who still lives in Waynesburg. At the age of 17, Neubauer became the third generation of his family to join the florist industry when he became the manager of his family's Waynesburg flower shop. In 1982, he moved to Fayette County and opened the current location of Neubauer's Flowers on South Gallatin Avenue in Downtown Uniontown.

Carrying on his family's tradition of giving back to their home communities, Neubauer has been actively involved in a number of organizations dedicated to promoting and revitalizing Uniontown. He has served on the boards for the Fayette County Chamber of Commerce, Fay-Penn Economic Development Council, Union Cemetery and Uniontown Downtown Business District Authority, among others. In 2015, he was recognized as the Fayette County Chamber's Citizen of the Year.

Neubauer has also been involved with the Uniontown Jaycees, Uniontown Lions Club, Storey Square Summer Concert Series, State Theatre Center for the Arts and the Laurel Highlands Strategic Planning Commission. Neubauer also actively participates in local school Career Days and supports many youth, sports and art programs, as well as preserving historic buildings in Downtown Uniontown.

Professionally, Neubauer is a past board member of Florists Transworld Delivery (FTD) District 3-E and previously served as the national director of FTD Region 3, representing more than 2,100 shops in Pennsylvania and western New York. At the age of 28, he was the youngest person ever elected to the National Board of FTD. Neubauer also belongs to the Society of American Florists and American Floral Endowment. He served on the Presidential Inaugural Design Team for Presidents Clinton and Bush and designed for the PGA 84 Lumber Classic from 2003-2006.
